Tattva Foundation is a Lucknow-based innovation-driven ICT4D research and development organization, which works at the intersection of communities, governance, and technology. Tattva envisions an equitable society where everyone has access to affordable and quality healthcare nearest to their home. Tattva is a scale-up expert which has designed, developed, and scaled up multiple pioneering digital health interventions developed using persuasive technologies and human-centred design science research approaches. Tattva's solutions have to date, reached about 75000 direct beneficiaries, primarily frontline workers, impacting 50 million. Tattva Foundation works in multiple domains under the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), specifically health, nutrition, livelihood, and environment.

The core offerings of the organization are:

- Design, develop, and operationalize integrated, open architecture, and ABDM-compliant Information communication and technology products such as e/mHealth tools, hospital management information system, labour room MIS, Enterprise Resource Planning IS, etc.
- Conduct public health research in the areas of maternal and neonatal child health, immunisation, nutrition, health system studies, including supply chain.
- Design and develop data science solutions also using ML/Al for predictive analysis in the area of public health, education, poverty and livelihood and other domains.



- Empowering Communities through Technology- We equip marginalized communities with digital skills, access to e-governance, and community-driven ICT tools to support socio-economic development.
- Strengthening Governance with ICT- Partnering with government bodies, we develop digital platforms that enhance transparency, efficiency, and citizen participation in public services.
- Innovating with Open-Source Tech- We create open-source solutions—from mobile apps to Al and IoT tools—that address development challenges in health, education, and agriculture.
- Research & Advocacy- Our research informs ICT4D policy and practice, promoting digital inclusion and evidence-based development strategies.
- **Collaborative Impact** Through partnerships across sectors, we build ecosystems that drive sustainable, inclusive growth.
- Scaling What Works- We specialize in scaling proven ICT4D innovations to create lasting, largescale impact.


Values:




